The last week of Nocturne @ Holland Festival

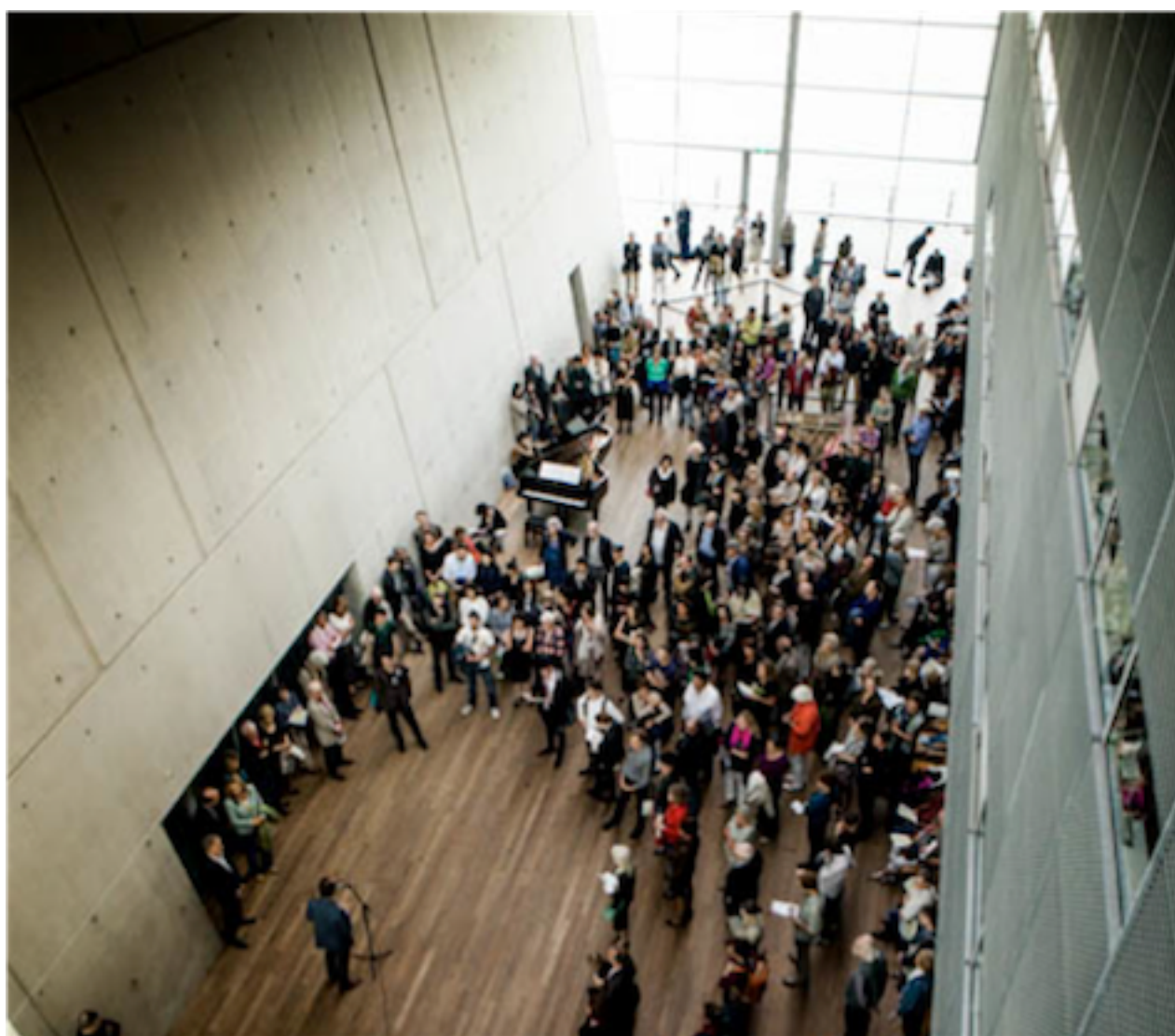
