Since we are not able to come together in the theatre or concert hall, what does that mean for our sense of interaction? How will we stimulate the next generation of actors, dancers and musicians to continue their craft, even if they're not able to go on stage? What is our new definition of a 'live' experience?

This situation leaves me with many questions and few answers. What I do know, is that I miss being on stage. The strength of performance art is to share time and space. I miss having a strong connection with my audience. Our starting point is always to share an experience, which has been made difficult for us. We are all experimenting to recreate this connection, searching for ways to bridge this feeling again. Because the crisis will not stop us from creating.

These alternatives give us the chance to play with our medium. In this time of the corona outbreak, I will be presenting my first performance on Friday the 1<sup>st</sup> of May, with my new project A Live. At 3 PM CEST, I will perform La Mode van Yannis Kyriakides in an empty hall at the Muziekgebouw aan 't IJ in Amsterdam. During the concert, there will be an active live light installation with 85 LED panels, created by cinematographer Reinier van Brummelen. You will be


