I am grateful to announce that we will be continuing our tour of END AND BEGINNING throughout the Netherlands.

END AND BEGINNING is my most recent installation-concert in collaboration with cinematographer Reinier van Brummelen to present two powerful compositions by Galina Ustvolskaya and Alexander Raskatov.

Ustovskaya's music has a strong universal power. We live in a time where values, systems and structures as we know them are crumbling down. 'Composition no'2 - Dies Irae' (1973) shows us the unconditional power of what it means to be a human being. It is through music that we are able to reconnect with our core conscience.

Raskatov's 'Bells' (2019) was specially written for END AND BEGINNING. 'Bells' is filled with new sonorities, surprising colours of harmonies and new musical vocabularies which remind us of the richness of nature and humankind. Both pieces show us the unconditionality of our existence, the things we tend to forget in these strange times under Covid.

Due to the current circumstances, only 30 people can watch the performance at a time. We will continue the tour next year, hopefully for a larger audience. We are also releasing the archive video soon, which will make it possible for you to see the performance online.
